## AUTHOR INSTRUCTIONS

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### 1. General

In order to ensure high quality of the volume of abstracts the authors are kindly asked to submit **two-page extended abstracts in English** in portable document format (pdf) suitable for photo-copying (camera ready). The aim of these extended abstracts is, firstly to advertise the topic considered in the paper and secondly to provide the readers with some detailed information. Please, describe briefly the area of interest, the basic assumptions and methods used, and highlight the main results of your contribution. A list of basic references is highly recommended.

Abstracts must reach the Organizing Committee for review by **January 31th, 2022**.

### 2. Paper size, margins and paper length

Use the standard A4 (210 × 297 mm) paper size. Allow 2 cm left, right, and bottom margins and a 3 cm top margin. Contributions longer than two pages or having bad presentation in terms of English language or typing quality will not be included in the volume of abstracts.

### 3. Font size, spacing, title, headings

Times Roman font of 11 point size should be used throughout with single spacing between lines of text. The title should be centered in all capital characters and bold face. Do not leave any additional space above the title. The title should be followed by authors' names (bold-italic) and respective affiliations (italic).

Page numbers, headers, and footers must *not* be typed.

### 4. Tables, figures, and equations

Tables and figures and their captions should be centered and numbered, leaving 12 points above and below the table or figure (see Table 1). Avoid grey-scale pictures that may not reproduce correctly.

Equations should be center aligned. Equation numbers (if necessary) should be placed in brackets at the left margin with no indentation,

(1) 
$$y = x^2 + \frac{\ln x}{x}.$$

Sufficient space (5 pt) should be left above and below the equation.
